Simple to install and highly effective, don't go thirsty again!

Step 1: Park vehicle on flat and level surface. Place gear selector in park and remove keys from the ignition.

Step 2: Remove outer half of clamshell cage clamps using 5/32" Allen wrench from both sides of cooler rack. Place all hardware and clamp pieces aside they will be re-used.



Step 3: Locate an area along the rear horizontal tube of roll cage in which you would like to mount your cooler rack. Set cage clamp against roll cage tube so that they are sitting flush. Loosely install outer halves of cage clamps and hardware retained in Step 2. Hold your rack at the angle that best fits the cooler you will be using. Snug all hardware evenly. (Note: downward angle of rack provides a tighter fit) (See figure A)



Step 4: Place cooler inside the cooler rack and secure into place by strapping down with supplied tie down. (Note: tie off slack so that it does not get tangled while driving) (See figure B)
